Number Recognition Lesson Plan

Instructions:

- Have the students come to the floor near a chalkboard for a class discussion. Introduce the day individually.
- Tell the students the number(s) they will be learning. Go over each one individually.
- First, have the students say the number out loud. Next, count to the number together as a class.
- Repeat this process for all of the numbers being reviewed for the day.
- After you have gone over each number, ask the students "What number(s) are we learning about today?" and have them remind you of the numbers. Review with the students (They will need to write the numbers on their own).
- Have the students go back to their seats and write the number(s) on their worksheets. Be sure the students write the number(s) on the lines provided. Then, make sure they are creative as they draw and color their pictures.

Number Review Lesson Plan

You will need:

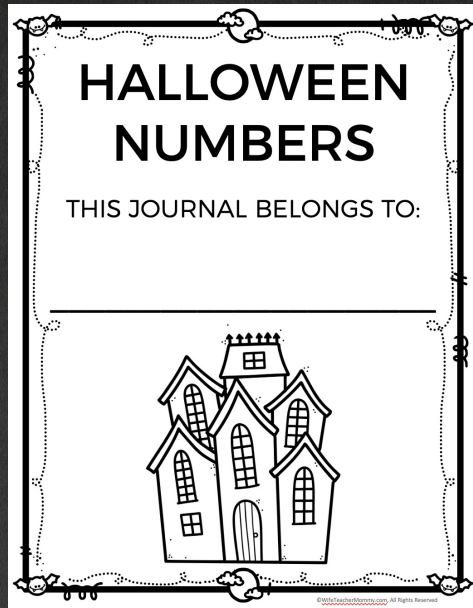
- Selection of number worksheets for the students
- Crayons, markers, colored pencils, etc.

Instructions:

- Have the students come to the floor near a white board or chalk board for a class discussion. Introduce the number(s) of the day individually.
- Tell the students the number(s) they will be reviewing as a class. Go over each one individually.
- First, have the students say the number out loud after you. Next, count to the number together as a class, using your fingers.
- Repeat this process for all of the numbers that will be reviewed for the day.
- After you have gone over each number, ask the students "What number(s) are we learning about today?" and have them remind you of the numbers. Review any questions the students have before sending them back to their seats.
- Have the students go back to their seats and hand out the Halloween "Write It, Circle, It, Draw It" number worksheets to go along with the number(s) discussed. Go over the directions with the students (They will need to write, circle, and draw)
- Walk around and assist students as they work on the worksheets. Be sure the students write their numbers and circle the pictures first. Then, make sure they use their creativity as they draw and color their pictures.



Draw It! Can you draw 7 pumpkins for sale?






