

### **Holiday Spelling Activity** Instructions

Each day of the week will have a different activity to practice spelling. You don't have to do the same page every day if you would like to switch it up! Everything is already created for you, so all you have to do is print what you need for the week and you're ready to

For every week, you will need to a copy of the Spin and Spell page and the Weekly Spelling Test for each student. There is also an optional Alphabetical Order organizer that can be printed each

Monday: One copy of the Weekly Spelling List, the Spooky Spin and Spell page, a paperclip, and a pencil for each student

- Pass out the Weekly Spelling List. Read the list of words together as a class and call on students to see if they know the meaning of each word. You can give them hints to look at prefixes, root words, or suffixes to help them find the meaning. This should be done before starting the activity
- Pass out the Spooky Spin and Spell page, a paperclip, and a pencil (if your students don't already have one). Have the students follow the directions on the spinner when they land
- Tuesday: One copy of the Wicked Word Boxes page for each





We have included multiple spelling list options for you to choose from when sending home spelling words. We have also created a list with each word's definition to be used by the teacher when introducing the week's spelling words.


