
Directed Drawings 3rd-6th Grade

Supplies needed:

- · Directed drawing worksheet and accompanying writing pages
- · Crayons, markers, etc. to color with
- Scratch paper

Instructions:

- · Give each child the step-by-step Directed Drawing worksheet.
- Have students follow each step to learn how to draw the assigned item on scratch paper prior to drawing their final item within a picture on the worksheet.
- They may continue to practice on scratch paper until you instruct them to move on or until they feel comfortable creating their final drawing.
- Tell them to draw their picture large so it takes up the full space in the box.
- Once they finish their picture, hand out the accompanying writing page.
- Students should write a story to accompany their picture while trying to keep the theme on the assigned drawing item.






The Instructions page gives you an idea of how to guide your students through the creation of their directed drawing! Everything you need is clearly listed along with steps so there is no guess work!
