TURKEY TROUBLE

1. Read aloud the book "Turkey Trouble" by Wendi Silvano. Gently discuss why the turkey may not like being a turkey near Thanksgiving. What would be a good disguise, tell the students to create a disguise for a turkey to wear on Thanksgiving.
2. Hand out the cardstock turkeys to the students and let them cut their turkey out and start using the classroom materials you have to create a disguise for a turkey to wear on Thanksgiving.
3. Once they have created their turkey, have them complete the sentence frame to give their turkey a full cardstock page.

TURKEY TROUBLE

1. Read aloud the book "Turkey Trouble" by Wendi Silvano. Gently discuss why the turkey may not like Thanksgiving.
2. Have the students pair-share what they would do if they were a turkey near Thanksgiving. What could they dress up as to disguise themselves?
3. Once your students have discussed what they think would be a good disguise, tell the student that they get to create a disguise for a turkey to wear around Thanksgiving.
4. Hand out the cardstock turkeys to each student and have them cut their turkey out and start creating their disguise using the classroom materials you choose to provide.
5. Once they have created their turkey's disguise, have them complete the sentence frame to glue under their turkey on a full cardstock page.

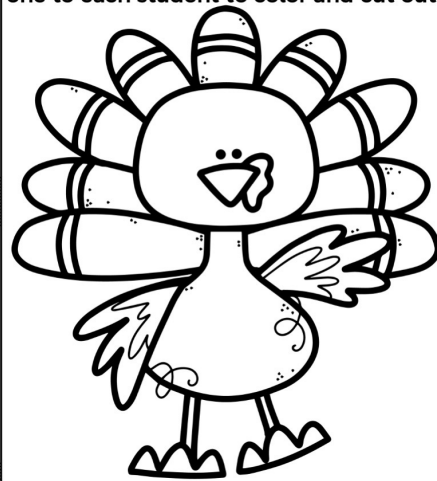
