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PLANET INFORMATION & MNEUMONIC DEVICE

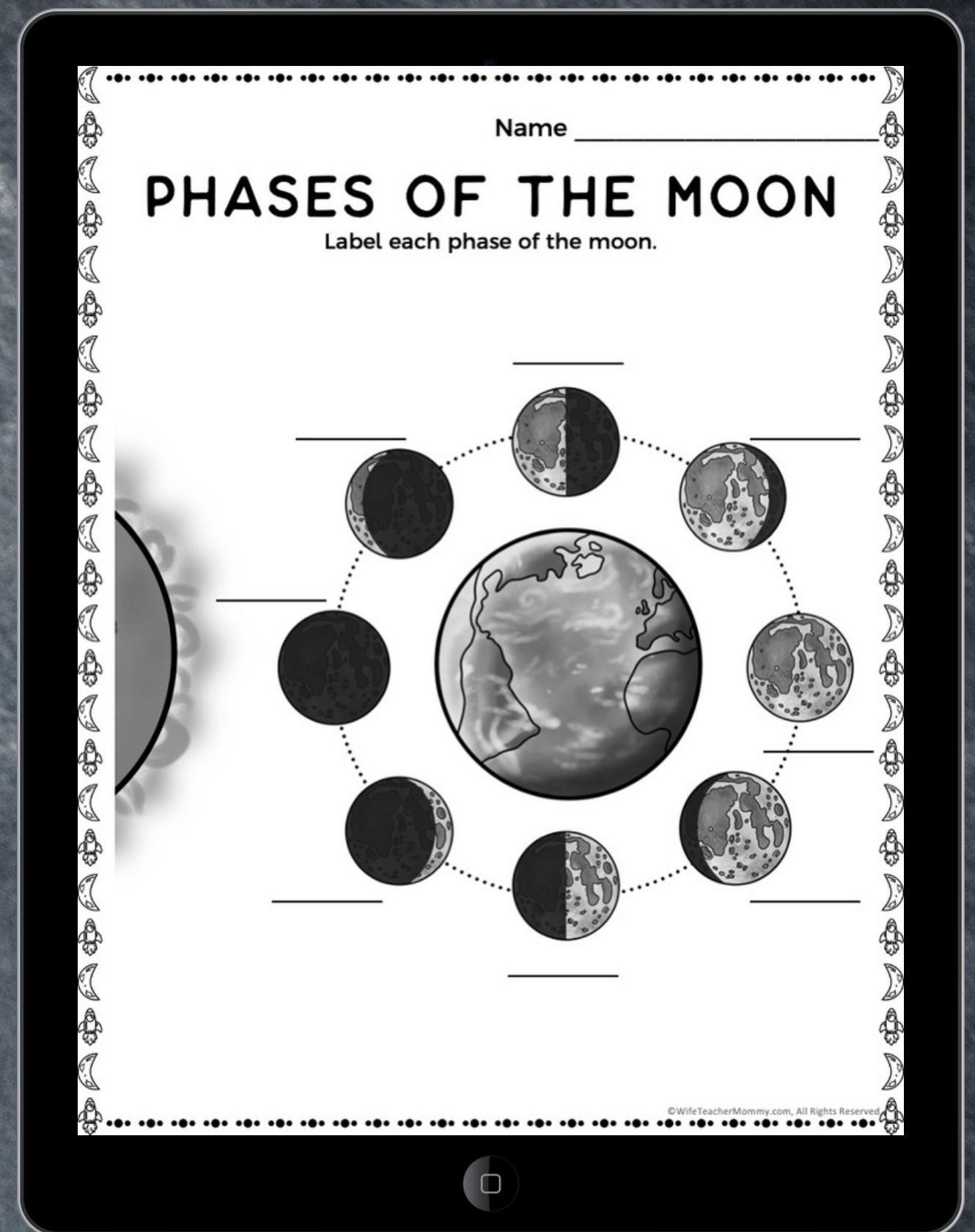
We have included


