Parts of an Apple

PARTS OF AN APPLE PLATE CRAFT

1. Pass around a whole apple and an apple that has been cut in half so that each student gets to explore the apple using their five senses. Lead a discussion about what they notice about the apple. Ask the students what adjectives describe the different parts of the apple. Show the class the parts of an apple posters.
2. Pass out the supplies to each student - paper plate, leaf, stem, red paint, or red paper.
3. Have the students start by taking their paper plates and ripping red paper or painting the red to outline the plate. This will represent the skin.
4. Then have the students cut out the leaf and stem and glue them to the top of the paper plate apple.
5. After that, students can use beans, and seeds, or draw the apple seeds in the center of the apple.
6. To take this activity to the next level, you could have each student label the parts of the apple.

Time:

- 10 Minutes Exploring the Apple and Discussion
- 15 Minutes Creating the Apple Diagram

Student Materials:

- Red Paper or Paint for the Apple's Skin
- Green Paper for Leaf
- Brown Paper for Stem
- Paper Plate for Apple
- Beans for Apple's Seeds
- Apple Part Posters

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CALYX

The calyx is located at the very bottom of the apple. It is made up of leafy sepals that protected the apple tree's blossom before the apple grew.

STEM

The stem is where the apple was connected to the tree.

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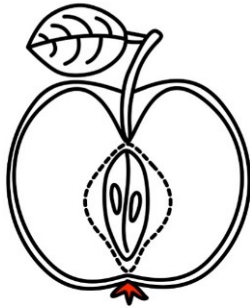
